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## **1. BACKGROUND**

**Life for all activities started in 2011 which was started by Paul winner,anja crauze and Rudolf winner.**

**MISSION. To give hope to orphans, the needy and vulnerable as well medical care and education development.**

## **2. MESSAGE FROM THE HEAD TEACHER**



It's a great opportunity I take to thank directors of life for all for the great commitment and work done in 2018.its also important to note that life for all in 2018 was the most successful year with great improvements and achievements.

## **3. STAFF**

Life all has a team of 22 workers at the site in nyamusasa and other workers voluntarily assisting plus life for all band .the staff was most peaceful and hard working up to the end of the year 2018 .

The staff is compost of the garden team, teachers, guards, sponsorship team, support team, life for all band.

## **4. SCHOOL**

Life for all school is benefiting 68 families, amounting to 103 children. Life for all school focuses mainly in three key things in 2018 for the school.

1. Performance,



Our children performed better than 2017 where 102 were able to be promoted to the next classes.

Our children have also improved in English speaking and handwriting.

1. Discipline

Life for all children were disciplined as there were no cases of serious indiscipline .this is because we usually have assemblies and individual sessions we always meet the learners every Thursday to share and advice them on how to leave well with one another.

2. Security of our children

There is a problem of child sacrifice in Uganda but 2018 ended well with all our children being safe.

3. Religious aspect to our children.

As the ministry grows, there is need for a religious leader .However, life for all is in a search and we have been building our children with the word of God every Friday morning for one hour before we start our normal lessons.

4. Medical attention.

Life for all gave usually refer sick children to a clinic in bweyale for treatment where they lfa meet the bill last year our children suffered illnesses such as malaria, caught, flue and accidents. We only had ayati shamim who suffered from heart related illness and lfa offered the family money for scanning and examination. Later she was given medicine to swallow as the condition is monitored.

## 5. NEIGHBOURHOOD PROJECT

There are 51 families benefiting from the project, 406 people including children being cared for by the 51 families who eat food they cultivate from lfa project.

Most beneficiaries now grow crops such as cassava, beans, sweet potatoes, groundnuts, maize and others. This is improving the lives of refugees from south Sudan that we are helping like 3 families and many who were affected by lord army and those who suffer domestic violence due to lack of land in their areas who are homeless but renting simple houses for settlement .Life for all offers beneficiaries with land for cultivation, seeds for those who cannot afford. The number there for increased from 33 families in 2017 to 51 families in 2018.Meaning that the size of land given to them keeps on decreasing and the number increases.

The project was also able to receive a new tractor from Germany to help in boosting the agricultural work hence enough food for the orphans and disadvantaged children.

Beneficiaries jubilated with thanks to the German helpers for sending for them tractor and offering gardens to them at no cost.

## 6. CONTAINER

We are glad that lfa received a container full of clothes, tools for tailoring, machines for carpentry work which is soon starting as one of the goals for life for all. We also received tractor and all great thanks to the directors, sponsors and well wishers for giving.

Many people were able to get clothes both children and adults and about 1000 people got clothes.

## 7. FENCE

I am grateful for the fence .Half our 70 Acre land is now fenced. I thank life for all Directors for the struggle to bring for us rolls of fence. At the moment we need again 25 rolls of fence to complete the fence. This will help in reducing high rate of theft.

We are still making more assessment and we believe that God willing we will be able to partner with them soon.

We received also visitors from our friendly organization for child protection headed by Frank. He did counseling to parents and children on specifically dangers of child abuse and teaching children on importance of discipline and respecting elders. He also told children to stay in school so that they acquire education given to them by life for all.

#### **14. ACHIEVEMENTS**

1. Half way of our land is fully fenced.
2. Life for all was able to host and keep visitors from both Uganda and abroad.
3. Life for all was able to complete the teacher's house. Fence work was completed.
4. We procured a guest house which will help in accommodating our visitors. That is mirembe guest house which is now licensed to operate.
5. Food production increased whereby we have maize that can feed our children up to next season.
6. Life for all was able to build a temporary structure for p.2 class.
7. We were able to add more 20 children bringing to a total of 103 children.
8. The number of people in neighbor's hood project increased from 31 to 51 beneficiaries.
9. Life for all was able to pay all bills and salaries for their workers.
10. Life for all band was able to complete their tour and gospel concert in Germany.

#### **15. CONCLUSION**

Life for all is hope for people around this area. people come in big numbers seeking to be recruited as member .This is because of efforts made by the directors ,sponsors ,volunteers and Ugandan team that is bringing peace in the organisation,unity,transparency,love,togetherness,academic excellence .I thank each and every one who has greatly contributed .
